SCHOOL CREST AND MOTTO



The red, dark blue and light blue stripes in the school crest are symbolic of the three arms of our Defence Services and the integrated concept of training in the initial stages.

The School motto "Gyan, Anushasan, Sahayog" enshrines three of the most essential qualities needed for a career in the Defence Services namely Knowledge, Discipline and Cooperation.





SAINIK SCHOOL

The concept of the Sainik School originated in the visionary mind of Late V K Krishna Menon, who was our Defence Minister in the early sixties. He felt that a school with rudiments of a military way of life, in each state of our country, could go a long way in building up an infrastructure for in-take into the National Defence Academy. He was also of the view that such institutions would serve as an ideal Alma-Mater for the hardy, intelligent sections of the boys, hailing especially from the rural areas of our country. Moreover, the high levels of physical, mental and intellectual attainments needed for induction into the Officer Cadre could not be nurtured in the common schools, mainly because of the lack of infrastructure facilities.

Sainik School Kazhakootam came into being on 20 Jan 1962, in a few barracks lent by the Indian Army at Pangode Military Station, Trivandrum. At the inception, a total of 120 students joined the school in classes V, VI, VII and VIII. Six months later class IX began with 12 students. Present strength is approximately 600 cadets from classes VI to XII. Girl cadets began to be inducted from the academic session 2021-22 and at present there are 58 girl cadets in the school. The Founder Principal was Lt Col BK Somaiah. The first Headmaster was Sqn Ldr Babu Lal and the Registrar was Capt TVS Nair.

GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS

1. Parents are welcome to visit their children on the Second Sundays as mentioned in the diary from 0900hrs to 1600 hrs. Please do not enter the campus to meet your children on other days. In case of an emergency requirement, please contact the Vice Principal / Administrative Officer first.
2. Out pass is sanctioned only on medical grounds on the recommendations of the Medical Officer. No other form of out pass is permitted. You are requested to plan all religious and family engagements during the school vacations.
3. All dormitories have telephone facilities. The cadets can ring up their parents twice a week. School has introduced video calling facility. All parents to download *mips-connect parent* app and install the same in their mobile phones from playstore. Do inform the school authorities in case your ward has any problems in the school or dormitory. However encourage them to write letters also.
4. Please do not hand over money or send money order to your ward. They are not permitted to keep any money on their person or in dormitories. All their personal expenditure will be met from their respective Pocket Money Account.
5. Security Guards at the entrance gates of the school have been briefed to ascertain the bonafides of all people entering and leaving the school. Please co-operate with the security personnel in this regard. Remember that this is being done to ensure the safety of your child inside the school campus.
6. Helmets/ Seat belts are compulsory within the school campus. Speed limit for all vehicle is 30 km per hour.
7. Parking of cars / two wheelers inside the campus is restricted to the area in the lower hockey ground only. Vehicles will not be parked or halted anywhere else on the campus. Cars / Two wheelers will not be driven around the school area and the dormitories. Cadets are not permitted to drive any vehicle inside the campus.





8. Please follow all the traffic rules and regulations strictly.
9. The school campus is a litter free and polythene free zone. Wrappers and polythene bags brought by the parents will be taken out by them and not littered around the campus. You are advised to bring a bag with you for carrying back the left over food, wrappers etc.
10. Parents are also requested not to smoke, drink or chew paan inside the school campus.
11. Parents are requested to pay the fees as per the schedule.
12. The bathrooms (Ladies and Gents) in the auditorium and adjacent to the Fort wall near the Parade ground are available for use by parents on Sundays. You are requested not to visit any other bathroom in the campus.
13. Cadets are not permitted to keep mobile phones or any other electronic items. Parents are advised to refrain from giving such items to their wards. Strict disciplinary action including withdrawal from the school will be undertaken in case of defaulters.
14. Dental out pass would be permitted only on Saturdays from 1430 h to 2100 h. No overnight out pass for this reason will be issued.
15. Parents visiting their wards are requested to refrain from entering the wings or study halls of the dormitories. They will meet their wards inside the House Master's office only in his presence.
16. Security Guards patrolling the campus have been briefed to ensure and enforce the regulations cited above. In case of any problem, please contact the Admin officer/Vice Principal.
17. Parents are requested not to bring any items in the plastic bags.

CADETS' MESS



General

1. Cadets' Mess is the formal central dining hall of Sainik School Kazhakootam. All members will conduct themselves with dignity and decorum at all times in the Mess.
2. All Cadets will be seated before the prayer bell.
3. Entry / Exit from the mess will always be in a dignified manner.
4. The prayer will be recited solemnly before and after each meal.
5. It is compulsory for all cadets to be present for all meals. Only cadets admitted in the infirmary are exempted.
6. Cadets will enter the mess in the prescribed dress only. Shirts will always be tucked in. Shoes will be worn.
7. Be courteous to the mess staff at all times. Complaints, if any, will be brought to the notice of the Mess Manager / Catering Assistant only. Suggestions/Recommendations if any may be entered in a register available in the mess.
8. Vegetarians / Non vegetarians will be seated in their designated seats only.
9. Do not tamper, touch or damage mess property or fitments. All damages/breakages attributable to cadets will be made good from cadet's pocket money accounts.
10. Cadets are not permitted to bring their guests to the mess.
11. Handle mess furniture with due care. Please stack the chairs as prescribed after each meal.





12. Music to be played in the mess during meal times. It will have the prior approval of Principal.
13. Silence during meal time is appropriate. Voice levels should never exceed a murmur.

Dining Etiquettes

14. Personal hygiene and cleanliness before, during and after meals at the mess will always be ensured (Washing of hands before and after every meal)
15. Sit straight while having your meal. Do not slouch over the table.
16. Do not shift the plates laid on the table. Make sure you use the plate laid for you only.
17. Do not speak with food in mouth. While chewing, the mouth should remain closed.
18. Pass the vessels / bowls of food as quickly as possible so that your fellow cadets also get the food in time.
19. Do not spill water on the tables or on the floor.
20. Eat well but avoid wastage. Remember wasting food is a sin.
21. Do not share the food served in your plate with others.
22. Avoid spilling water while using the cooler.
23. Do not litter. Help us to keep the mess premises clean at all times.
24. Spoons and forks provided will be used in the correct manner specified.
25. While dining, elbows will not be placed on the table.
26. Please follow all mess instructions in letter and spirit.

Eligibility for Compartment

- (a) Class IX: A cadet offering 5 subjects and failing in up to two of the five subjects of Year End/ Centralised Exam shall be placed in compartment in those subjects provided he/she qualifies in all the subjects of internal assessment.
- (b) Class XI: A cadet failing in one of the five subjects of Year End/ Centralised Exam shall be placed in compartment in that subject provided he/she qualifies in all subjects of internal assessment.

ELIGIBILITY FOR CONTINUATION/RETENTION OF DEFENCE/STATE GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP

- (a) If a Cadet obtains a minimum of 45% in each subject and an aggregate of 55 % in the overall results for classes VI to XI.
- (b) SC/ST Cadets are required to obtain a minimum of 33% marks in each subject and an aggregate of 33% in the overall results.
